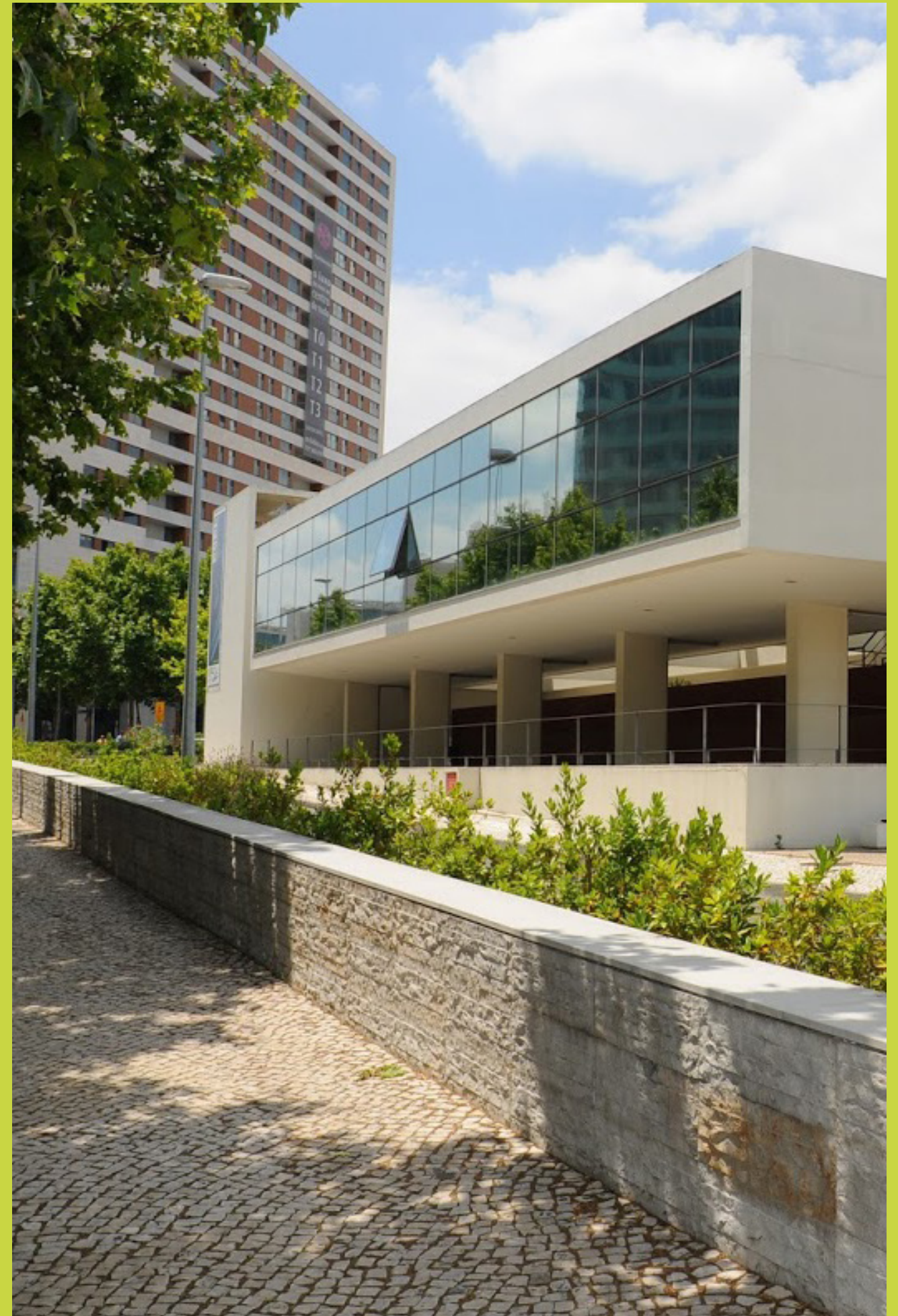
Research that improves care
